CONTEST RULES:

All U.S. federal, state, local and municipal laws and regulations apply. Void where prohibited.

TO ENTER AND PLAY: In order to be eligible for the contest, the signature of parent or guardian must be provided. The contest will begin at 12:01 a.m. (EST) on June 1, 2007 and conclude July 10, 2007 (the "contest period"). To be considered, all entries must be date stamped with a postmark no later than July 10, 2007, the conclusion of the contest period. Sponsors will not be responsible for incomplete, lost, late, illegible, or misdirected entries.

ELIGIBILITY: The contest is open only to New Jersey students enrolled in grades K-12 at the beginning of the contest period. All entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian with the understanding that the Grand Prize-winning student may be eligible for a ride on a hot-air balloon during the scheduled morning ascension on Saturday, July 28, at the Quick Chek New Jersey Festival of Ballooning, held at Solberg Airport in Readington, NJ. The hot-air balloon flight is subject to weather conditions and may be cancelled at anytime without notice. In the event of cancellation, sponsors will make every effort to reschedule. If balloon flight cannot be rescheduled, an alternate prize of a \$100 gift certificate from a New Jersey book retailer will be awarded to the winning student. If the winning student is prohibited from flying on a hot-air balloon for any reason he or she will receive the alternate prize.

WINNER NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE: The parent or guardian named in the entry of each student winner will be notified via mail at the address specified in the entry during the week of July 16, 2007. Prizes are non-assignable and non-transferable. A parent or guardian of the Grand Prize winner must accompany Grand Prize winner to the hot-air balloon launch site and on the hot-air balloon ride. Failure to comply with any term or condition of these official rules may, at the sole discretion of sponsors, result in a winner's disqualification, the forfeiture of his or her interest in the prize, and the awarding of prize to an alternate winner. Except where prohibited, acceptance of contest prizes constitutes consent to the publication of his or her name and image in any media for any commercial or promotional purpose, without limitation or further compensation. Sponsors reserve the right to cancel or modify the contest if they determine, at their sole discretion, that fraud or technical failures have destroyed the integrity of the contest.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: By participating in the contest, contestant agrees that (1) any disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of or connected with the contest, or any prizes awarded, shall be resolved individually without resort to any form of class action; (2) any claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering the contest but in no event attorneys' fees; and (3) under no circumstances will any contestant obtain any award for, and entrant hereby waives all rights to claim punitive, incidental or consequential damages, any rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased, and any other damages other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses.

If any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these rules shall otherwise remain in effect and be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained herein.
